| 9  | 1. That § 22.1-298.8 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:                                      |
| 10 | § 22.1-298.8. Public elementary and secondary school teachers; certain training activities;                            |
| 11 | requirements and limitations.  |
| 12 | A. As used in this section, "non-academic training activity" means any training activity in which any                  |
| 13 | public elementary or secondary school teacher is required to participate that is not related to the teacher's          |
| 14 | instructional, academic, or curricular duties.   |
| 15 | B. Notwithstanding any other provision of law:   |
| 16 | 1. No public elementary or secondary school teacher shall be required to participate more frequently than              |
| 17 | once within six months of employment with the applicable school board and once every five years thereafter             |
| 18 | in any non-academic training described in clause (iii) of subsection A of § 22.1-279.6 or activity, provided,          |
| 19 | however, that participation in additional training relating to secure mandatory test violations as set forth in        |
| 20 | §§ 22.1-19.1 and 22.1-292.1 <del>, unless</del> may be required upon the determination of the school board or division |
| 21 | superintendent determines that such additional training is necessary to comply with federal or state law or to         |
| 22 | remediate misconduct. Each teacher who completes any such training shall sign a written attestation that the           |
| 23 | teacher has been trained in and understands the relevant subject matter.   |
| 24 | 2. The total frequency and duration of non-academic training activities in which each public elementary                |
| 25 | or secondary school teacher is required to participate pursuant to (i) state law or regulation or (ii) policy or       |
| 26 | regulation of the applicable school board shall not exceed 20 hours every two years.                                   |
