6	A BILL to require the Chronic Absenteeism Task Force to examine chronic student absenteeism and its
7	effects on local school divisions and school accountability; report.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. The Chronic Absenteeism Task Force convened by the Department of Education, in consultation with
10	such interested stakeholders as it deems appropriate, shall (i) examine chronic student absenteeism and its
11	effects on local school divisions, with a particular focus on the intersection between chronic student
12	absenteeism and the analysis of readiness for the purpose of school accountability under the School
13	Performance and Support Network, and (ii) make recommendations to the Board of Education, the
14	Governor, and the General Assembly no later than November 1, 2025, on the feasibility and advisability of
15	amending 8VAC20-110-130 of the Virginia Administrative Code or any other relevant Board of Education
16	regulation to exclude certain student absences from the calculation of chronic student absenteeism to
17	balance the importance of student attendance with the need for administrative flexibility for local school
18	divisions and flexibility for families based on unique or unforeseen circumstances.
