HOUSE BILL NO. 2637 AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Education and Health

on February 13, 2025)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate LeVere Bolling)

A BILL to direct the Department of Education, in collaboration with the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services, to incentivize and facilitate participation in the Mental Health First Aid Program by public school staff and students.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

9 10 1. § 1. The Department of Education, in collaboration with the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services, shall develop and implement a plan to incentivize and facilitate participation in the 11 12 Commonwealth Mental Health First Aid Program (the Program), established pursuant to § 37.2-312.2 of 13 the Code of Virginia, by public school staff and students. Such plan shall (i) ensure that training provided 14 pursuant to the Program is offered at several public schools in school divisions across the Commonwealth 15 and at a variety of dates and times, including during and outside of the school day, to provide flexibility and maximize opportunities for participation by public school staff and students; (ii) include strategies for 16 17 incentivizing or encouraging public school staff and students to participate in such training; (iii) provide for 18 the development and dissemination of informational materials for public school staff and students that (a) 19 describe the Mental Health First Aid Program and the benefits of participating in such training, (b) list the 20 dates, times, and locations at which such training shall be offered, and (c) clearly state that such training 21 provided pursuant to the Program is available at no cost to public school staff or students; and (iv) include 22 any other strategies deemed appropriate or effective for incentivizing participation in or facilitating the

23 provision of such training.
