**Bill Number:** HB1905 ER

**Bill Title:** Compounded drugs; exceptions for distribution within health system under common ownership.

**Bill Summary:** Allows for the distribution of compounding drugs within a health system under common ownership when such drugs will be administered only to patients within the hospital or health system.

**Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**Items Impacted:** n/a

**Explanation:** Any fiscal impacts are minimal and can be absorbed with existing resources. This bill does not require that language changes be made to the proposed Appropriation Act.

**Fiscal Summary:** Any fiscal impacts resulting from this bill are minimal and can be absorbed within existing resources.

**Fiscal Analysis:** The Board of Pharmacy will be required to recognize the provisions of this bill as part of their existing inspection regimen. The Board expects that adapting to such changes can be handled within existing resources.

**Other:** HB 1905 as enrolled is a companion bill to SB 1366 S1.
