The analysis shall provide information on the time to collect such receivables and any recommendations for amendments to Virginia law based upon the best practices related to the statute of limitations, revenue impacts, and collection techniques in other states. The Department of Taxation shall report on the findings and recommendations of such analysis and submit such report to the Chairs of the Senate Committee on Finance and Appropriations and House Committee on Appropriations by November 1, 2025.
