Bill Title: School-connected overdoses; policies relating to parental notification and response;

requirements.

Bill Summary: Expands current law relating to school-connected overdose parental notification and response policies to apply to private elementary and secondary schools in the Commonwealth and include school-connected student opioid antagonist treatment. Requires division superintendents and heads of private elementary and secondary schools in the Commonwealth to report certain information to the parents of enrolled students within 24 hours of a confirmed school-connected student overdose or school-connected student opioid antagonist treatment. Requires each local school board and each private elementary or secondary school to adopt, implement, and maintain policies consistent with the provisions of the bill and the guidelines developed by the Board of Education.
