Bill Title: Payment of costs when proceedings deferred and defendant placed on probation.

Bill Summary: Current law requires a circuit or district court to impose costs upon a defendant when the court has deferred further proceedings without entering a judgment of guilt and has placed a defendant on probation subject to terms and conditions enumerated in the bill. This bill prohibits a court from entering a judgment of guilt against such defendant solely for his failure to pay such costs or other fees and requires the court to comply with the terms agreed upon for the deferral if all other terms and conditions of such agreement are satisfied provided that such costs or other fees remain due.
