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Bill Number: HB2415S1 **Patron:** Cousins Public housing authorities; indigent parties; unlawful detainer.

Bill Summary: The bill exempts indigent defendants, as defined in the bill, from posting an appeal bond in unlawful detainer actions brought by a public housing authority. The bill also amends the Virginia Residential Landlord and Tenant Act to (i) prohibit public housing authorities from charging tenants fees for maintenance or repair unless caused by the tenant's action or omission, and (ii) require that when such a public housing authority issues a notice of nonpayment of rent, it must also provide the tenant with information on pink or orange paper. Such information should explain how the tenant can recertify their income, report income changes, request a minimum rent hardship exemption, and file grievances, in accordance with federal law. Information is required to be posted by the public housing authority in conspicuous locations in each public housing community under its authority.

Explanation: This bill involves the Department of Housing and Community Development and the Courts;
