An Act to amend and reenact §§ 54.1-3446 and 54.1-3452 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Drug Control Act; Schedule I; Schedule IV.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That §§ 54.1-3446 and 54.1-3452 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 54.1-3446. Schedule I.

The controlled substances listed in this section are included in Schedule I:

719 6. The Board may except by regulation any compound, mixture, or preparation containing any depressant

721 mixture, or preparation contains one or more active medicinal ingredients not having a depressant effect on
722 the central nervous system, and if the admixtures are included therein in combinations, quantity, proportion,
723 or concentration that vitiate the potential for abuse of the substances which have a depressant effect on the
724 central nervous system.

725 **2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or**
726 **commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary**
727 **appropriation is \$0 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be**
728 **determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.**
