health first aid training provided to adults through DBHDS. If DBHDS is responsible for the costs, the existing funding could be reprogrammed to meet these requirements, however it would result in fewer trainings provided under the current program as the agency expends nearly all training funds each year. While the total cost of developing and offering the new training is indeterminate and dependent on vendors, the cost of training a new trainer under the existing program is \$1,500, and each 30 person training class costs between \$569 and \$719 per 8 hour session.
