Bill Title: Department of Environmental Quality; emergency administrative regulations; emergency

engines.

Bill Summary: Allows emergency generators to operate up to 50 hours per year for nonemergency purposes, such as planned outages and testing, in alignment with federal regulations. The bill defines affected emergency generators as those certified by the U.S. Department of Defense as essential for national defense. The Department of Environmental Quality is tasked with incorporating these provisions into existing regulations without further action from the State Air Pollution Control Board. The bill has an emergency clause.

Explanation: This bill involves the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ); however, no budget
