Bill Title: School-connected overdoses; policies relating to parental notification and response;

requirements.

Bill Summary: Requires public school principals and heads of private elementary and secondary schools in the Commonwealth to report certain information to the parents of enrolled students within 24 hours of a confirmed or suspected school-connected student overdose. Requires each local school board and each private elementary or secondary school to adopt, implement, and maintain policies consistent with the provisions of the bill and the guidelines developed by the Board of Education.
