**Bill Summary:** Directs the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia and the Department of Veterans Services to submit to the Senate Committee on Finance and Appropriations and the House Committee on Appropriations by December 15 of each year a report on i) the number of qualified survivors and dependents who have been determined to be eligible for a waiver of tuition and mandatory fees at a public institution of higher education pursuant to the Virginia Military Survivors and Dependents Education Program but have not yet enrolled at such an institution and (ii) the best available estimate of the number of qualified survivors and dependents who are enrolled at each public institution of higher education with a waiver of tuition and mandatory fees pursuant to the Program as of December 1 of the current fall semester.
