2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 15.2-978 of the Code of Virginia, relating to registration by localities of*
3 *cemeteries on private property.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 15.2-978 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**8 **§ 15.2-978. Registration by locality of cemeteries, graveyards, or other places of burial on private**
9 **property.**

10 Any locality may, *and in Planning District 8 all localities shall*, adopt an ordinance setting forth a register
11 of identified cemeteries, graveyards, or other places of burial located on private property not belonging to any
12 memorial or monumental association. The official local register may include an official map. Sites on the
13 registry shall not be disclosed to the public in any format if they fall under the exception provided in
14 subdivision 10 of § 2.2-3705.7 for significant historic and archaeological sites that would be jeopardized by
15 public disclosure of their location. The register and official map may be available on the locality's website, if
16 one exists. The locality may provide a phone number and email address on the locality's website, if one
17 exists, that members of the public can use to contact the locality regarding identified or unidentified
18 cemeteries, graveyards, or other places of burial located on private property not belonging to any memorial or
19 monumental association.

20 The governing body shall publish a notice in a newspaper having general circulation in the locality at least
21 two weeks prior to the public sale of any publicly owned property that contains a known cemetery, graveyard,
22 or other place of burial, or as soon thereafter as possible, and shall also publish the notice on the locality's
23 website, if one exists. The notice shall specify that a cemetery is present on the property. If the property falls
24 under the exception provided in subdivision 10 of § 2.2-3705.7 for significant historic and archeological sites
25 that would be jeopardized by public disclosure of their location, then no such notice is required.

26 **2. That the provisions of this act shall become effective on July 1, 2026.**
