WHEREAS, Aubrey Jones has also advocated for criminal justice and gun safety reform and organized community members around important issues: and

WHEREAS, Aubrey Jones has worked directly with people whose lives have been affected by tragedies, offering hope and support in times of need; now, therefore, be it
