Bill Title: Virginia Public Procurement Act; Additional public works contract requirements.

Bill Summary: Provides that public bodies shall require the contractor and its subcontractors for non-transportation related construction projects to complete certain safety training programs, maintain records of compliance with applicable laws, and participate in approved apprenticeship training programs. The substitute provides exemptions from such requirements for reasons related to lack of availability of apprentices and high costs. The bill has a delayed effective date of July 1st, 2026.

Budget Amendment Necessary: No Items Impacted:

Explanation: The fiscal impact of this legislation is indeterminate.

Fiscal Summary: The fiscal impact of this legislation is indeterminate. This bill may affect the pool of contractors and the price of non-transportation related construction projects.

Fiscal Analysis: The bill impacts non-transportation related construction projects by requiring contractors and subcontractors participate in apprenticeship programs. The bill requires contractors and subcontractors to provide reports certifying apprentice labor hours worked and the applicable trade in which the work was performed on the project. This requirement could potentially limit the pool of bidders and increase bid price.

This bill applies to all public bodies subject to the Virginia Public Procurement Act (VPPA). This bill does not apply to higher education institutions operating under Management Agreements and Memoranda of Understanding in the operational area of procurement (currently fourteen Level III and Level II institutions). Additionally, the bill will not apply to local governments that have exempted themselves from the VPPA as authorized by § 2.2-4343 (9, 10, 11).

Other: This legislation is similar to SB962.
