Bill Title: Hospitals; urine drug screening; fentanyl.

Bill Summary: Requires hospitals with an emergency department, when conducting a urine drug screening, as defined in the bill, to assist in diagnosing a patient's condition, to include testing for fentanyl in such urine drug screening. The provisions of this act shall become effective on January 1, 2026.

Budget Amendment Necessary: No. Items Impacted: None.

Fiscal Summary: Any anticipated impact is minimal and can be absorbed by the Virginia Department of Health.
