Bill Title: Jail superintendents to report certain acts of violence occurring within regional correctional

facilities to law-enforcement agency; policies.

Bill Summary: The bill requires the jail superintendent of any regional correctional facility to promptly report to the primary local law-enforcement agency in the jurisdiction where such correctional facility is located any act of violence set out in § 19.2-297.1 (Sentence of person twice previously convicted of certain violent felonies) that occurs within such correctional facility.

The bill also requires each regional correctional facility to adopt a policy setting forth the procedures for the investigation of such acts of violence and the respective roles and responsibilities of the jail superintendent of such correctional facility and the law-enforcement agency to which such report is made. Each regional correctional facility must provide a copy of such policy to the State Board of Local and Regional Jails prior to January 1 each year, beginning on January 1, 2026.
