**Bill Number:** HB2201ER **Patron:** McQuinn  
**Bill Title:** Public schools; temporarily employed teachers; rules and requirements; extension of time limitation.

**Bill Summary:** Extends from 90 to 180 days the maximum period of time during one school year for which a school board may employ a temporarily employed teacher, as defined in relevant law, to fill a teacher vacancy, with certain conditions and restrictions. The bill has an expiration date of July 1, 2027.
