HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 456

Commending the Auburn High School girls' soccer team.

WHEREAS, the Auburn High School girls' soccer team won the Virginia High School League Class 1 state championship in June 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Auburn High School Eagles rallied from an early two-goal deficit and defeated the Northumberland High School Indians by a score of 6–2; and

WHEREAS, the Auburn Eagles finished the season with an impressive 19–4 overall record, including a perfect 13–0 record against the other members of the Mountain Empire Region; and

WHEREAS, Auburn midfielder Katie Light recorded 49 goals and 16 assists during her senior season and was selected as the Virginia High School League (VHSL) Class 1 Player of the Year, while Auburn's Adam Ritchie was selected as the VHSL Class 1 Coach of the Year; and

WHEREAS, the victory is a testament to the hard work and dedication of all the student-athletes, the leadership and guidance of coaches and staff, and the passionate support of family members, friends, and the entire Auburn High School community; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby commend the Auburn High School girls' soccer team on winning the Virginia High School League Class 1 state championship in 2024; and, be it
