WHEREAS, the Charlottesville-Albemarle SPCA is contracted by the City of Charlottesville and Albemarle County to provide public animal sheltering services; and

WHEREAS, the Charlottesville-Albemarle SPCA bases every decision on a commitment to animal welfare and industry best practices; and

WHEREAS, the Charlottesville-Albemarle SPCA is dedicated to breaking down barriers and enhancing accessibility to services, resources, and information for pet owners; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby commend the Charlottesville-Albemarle Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals on the occasion of its 110th anniversary; and, be it
