Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. § 1. In at least one biennial review proceeding or other appropriate proceeding for a Phase I or Phase II Utility, as those terms are defined in subdivision A 1 of § 56-585.1 of the Code of Virginia, filed after January 1, 2025, but no later than July 1, 2027, the State Corporation Commission (the Commission) shall, under its existing authority, determine whether the Phase I or Phase II Utility is using rates, tolls, charges, or schedules that contain reasonable classifications of customers. In making this determination, the Commission shall consider whether new or separate customer classifications are reasonable.
