WHEREAS, Wathiq Alakelee named his business The Confident Barbershop both because his given name means "confident" in Arabic and because confidence is the feeling he wishes to instill in every customer he sees; and

WHEREAS, The Confident Barbershop has thrived under Wathiq Alakelee's leadership, earning hundreds of five-star reviews on Google and drawing in more return customers every day; and

WHEREAS, Wathiq Alakelee has served as a mentor to many aspiring barbers, offering them guidance and support to help them in their careers; and

WHEREAS, Wathiq Alakelee's accomplishments with The Confident Barbershop are a testament to the power of the American Dream and what may be achieved through exceptional dedication and hard work; now, therefore, be it
