HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 669

Commending the National Center for Healthy Veterans at Valor Farm.

WHEREAS, community is at the heart of Valor Farm, serving as an antidote to the isolation, loneliness, and fractured relationships that many veterans face upon their return to civilian life; now, therefore, be it
