WHEREAS, the Glenvar High School boys' swim team of Roanoke County won the Virginia High School League Class 2 state championship in 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Glenvar High School Highlanders had five first-place finishers, two second-place finishers, and one third-place finisher in 11 events, earning a total of 280 points in the state final to defeat the runners-up from Radford High School by 75 points; and

WHEREAS, freshman Aspen Thompson won the 100 backstroke event and set a school record during his third-place finish in the 200 freestyle event; and

WHEREAS, junior Landon Cairns won the 200 individual medley event by nearly seven seconds and set a school record during his second-place finish in the 100 breaststroke event; and

WHEREAS, senior Alec McIlwain finished first in the 500 freestyle event, winning by more than 21 seconds to set a school record; and

WHEREAS, senior Connor Wilkes, one of the most decorated swimmers in Glenvar High School history, took second place in the 50 freestyle event; and

WHEREAS, the team of Aspen Thompson, Landon Cairns, Connor Wilkes, and Avery Thompson set a new school record while winning the 200 medley relay, while the team of Aspen Thompson, Landon Cairns, Connor Wilkes, and Alec McIlwain also won the 200 freestyle relay; and

WHEREAS, the victorious season was a tribute to the skill and perseverance of all the student-athletes, the leadership and guidance of coaches and staff, and the unwavering support of family members, friends, and the entire Glenvar High School community; now, therefore, be it
