WHEREAS, Andre L. Weaver, Sr., a distinguished law-enforcement officer in Suffolk, died on February 20, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Andre Weaver was born and raised in Suffolk, graduating from John F. Kennedy High School, where he played trumpet in the marching band; and

WHEREAS, Andre Weaver continued his education at Virginia State University for one year and Paul D. Camp Community College for two years; after marrying his wife, Patrice, he began working at his father-in-law's business, Atlantic Ice Company; and

WHEREAS, Andre Weaver subsequently joined the Suffolk Police Department and served as a patrol officer, detective, and school resource officer between 1985 and 2014; in 2015, he transferred to the Suffolk Sheriff's Office until his retirement in 2023; and

WHEREAS, Andre Weaver used his experience in law enforcement to establish his own business, Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design, which provided crime prevention solutions in local schools and throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, Andre Weaver will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his wife of 46 years, Patrice; his son Andre, Jr., and his family; and numerous other family members and friends; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of Virginia hereby note with great sadness the loss of Andre L. Weaver, Sr.; and, be it
