Celebrating the life of Calvin Coolidge Tyler, Sr.

WHEREAS, in later life, Calvin Tyler continued to perform with his sons and nephews as a member of the Gospel Tears of Jarratt and with his grandchildren as the Gospel T's of Jarratt; and

WHEREAS, Calvin Tyler understood the value of hard work and responsibility, spending much of his career as a farmer and steel worker; and

WHEREAS, Calvin Tyler remained a loyal member of the congregation at Morning Star Baptist Church and was recognized for his 70 years of service on the usher board; and

WHEREAS, Calvin Tyler will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his wife of 78 years, Virginia; his children, Calvin, Jr., Linrod, Rochelle, Rufus, Welton, Rita, and Nathelia, and their families; and numerous other family members and friends; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Delegates hereby note with great sadness the loss of Calvin Coolidge Tyler, Sr.; and, be it
