WHEREAS, Gina Meekins-Tanks finished her career as a member of The Union Mission Ministries, where she provided essential services to people experiencing homelessness and helped hundreds of individuals regain their self-esteem and dignity; and

WHEREAS, Gina Meekins-Tanks will be fondly remembered by her children, Tiffany and Andre, and their families; her mother, Betty; her life partner, Wesley; and numerous other family members and friends; now, therefore, be it
