WHEREAS, for three years, Zayd Hamid was a leading member of GMU's Mason Lobbies events at the General Assembly, meeting with dozens of members to advocate for greater support of the Commonwealth's universities and students; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, Zayd Hamid joined the Student Aid Alliance at a panel on Capitol Hill to share his experience and to convey to United States congressional staff the importance and value of federal student aid programs; and

WHEREAS, beyond his advocacy work, Zayd Hamid has made an outsized impact on GMU and his fellow students through his involvement with a variety of student government boards and committees; and

WHEREAS, with a tireless work ethic and passion for GMU and its community, Zayd Hamid also served as a Patriot Leader for orientation and as a resident advisor, making a difference in the lives of countless students: and

WHEREAS, in recognition of his advocacy and service, Zayd Hamid received the inaugural Student Advocate of the Year Award from the Top Lobbyist section of the National Institute for Lobbying and Ethics

WHEREAS, through his extraordinary ability to bring people together around worthwhile causes, Zayd Hamid has demonstrated great promise as a leader of the next generation; now, therefore, be it
