Celebrating the life of Thomas Edward Mason, Sr.

WHEREAS, Thomas Mason graduated from Chincoteague High School and served his country with honor and distinction as a member of the United States Coast Guard; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Mason acquired business experience early in his career working with his father in the Jones and Mason Gas Station and Garage; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Mason later partnered with his wife, Donna, to open the oyster shucking and seafood business Mason Seafood, followed by the Waterside Inn and a venture selling aquacultured oysters and clams; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Mason was a well-respected, prominent, and proud member of the Chincoteague Island community, recognized for his entrepreneurial spirit, his work in the seafood and hospitality industries, and his contributions to local aquaculture; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Mason had a passion for working on the water, and he partnered with the Virginia Institute of Marine Science on research and development projects; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Mason knew that a sustainable shellfish industry in the Commonwealth could only be achieved from a healthy combination of wild and domestic clams and oysters; in recognition of his leadership and expertise, he was named to the Virginia Marine Resources Commission's Blue-Ribbon Oyster Panel; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Mason was a passionate leader who partnered with friends in the fabrication industry to develop aquaculture equipment, much of which is still used today; and

WHEREAS, Thomas Mason will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his wife of 57 years, Donna; his son, Thomas, Jr., and his family; and numerous other family members, friends, and colleagues; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Delegates hereby note with great sadness the loss of Thomas Edward Mason, Sr., a distinguished member of the Chincoteague business community and a leader in the aquaculture community on the Eastern Shore; and, be it
