Commending Timbaland.

Agreed to by the House of Delegates, October 27, 2025

WHEREAS, Timbaland, a native of Hampton Roads, has represented the Commonwealth for decades as one of the preeminent artists and producers in modern music; and

WHEREAS, born Timothy Zachery Mosley, Timbaland graduated from Virginia Beach's Salem High School: and

WHEREAS, Timbaland grew his craft as a young creative in Virginia Beach while working with other notable local artists such as Missy Elliott, Magoo, Clipse (with Pusha T and No Malice), and his cousin Pharrell Williams; and

WHEREAS, Timbaland has achieved major critical and commercial success in his career with two Number 1 Billboard Hits with "Promiscuous" and "Give It To Me"; and

WHEREAS, Timbaland's second solo studio album, *Shock Value*, was certified as 3x Platinum in the United States and reached Top 5 on the US Billboard 500, just one in his long list of Platinum records and Billboard achievements both as a solo artist and producer; and

WHEREAS, Timbaland has been nominated for 21 Grammy Awards, winning four, including two for "Best R&B Song" and two for "Best Dance Recording" with artists Justin Timberlake and Beyonce; and

WHEREAS, the City of Virginia Beach honored Timbaland's contributions and influence to the vibrant culture of the region by dedicating Bridle Creek Boulevard as "Timbaland Way" in October 2025 and awarding him with the Key to the City; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, That Timbaland hereby be commended for his achievements in music and contributions to culture around the world; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to Timbaland as an expression of the House of Delegates' admiration for his achievements and best wishes for the future.
