Commending the Epsilon Sigma Boulé of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity.

WHEREAS, the Epsilon Sigma Boulé of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity in Prince William County is celebrating its 10th anniversary in 2025, marking a decade of leadership, scholarship, and community service; and

WHEREAS, Sigma Pi Phi, also known as the Boulé, was founded in 1904 and is the nation's oldest Black Greek-letter fraternity for men of professional distinction; it has long provided a vital space for fellowship, intellectual engagement, and professional advancement for African American leaders; and

WHEREAS, for more than a century, Sigma Pi Phi has demonstrated a steadfast commitment to servant leadership and social advocacy, working to advance the Black community through civic engagement and by investing in Black businesses and promoting representation in executive leadership and corporate governance; and

WHEREAS, since its chartering on June 13, 2015, the Epsilon Sigma Boulé has carried forward this proud legacy; under the leadership of Archon Luke E. Torian, the Epsilon Sigma Boulé has invested in youth mentoring and science, technology, engineering, and mathematics education, support for the performing arts, college scholarships, and initiatives that expand opportunity for minority students; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, That the Epsilon Sigma Boulé of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity hereby be commended on the occasion of its 10th anniversary; and, be it
