9 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**10 **1. That § 17.1-917 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is  
11 amended by adding in Article 4 of Chapter 3 of Title 19.2 a section numbered 19.2-43.1 as follows:**  
12 **§ 17.1-917. Assistance and information; complaint forms.**13 A. State and local public bodies and departments, officers and employees thereof, and officials and all  
14 personnel of the courts of the Commonwealth shall cooperate with and give reasonable assistance and  
15 information to the Commission and any authorized representative thereof in connection with any  
16 investigations or proceedings within the jurisdiction of the Commission.17 B. In all state courts within the Commonwealth a sign shall be posted in a location accessible to the public  
18 that notes the availability of and provides instructions to obtain a downloadable electronic version of any  
19 standardized form developed and utilized by the Judicial Inquiry and Review Commission for the filing of a  
20 complaint from the official website of the judicial system of the Commonwealth. *Any standardized form  
21 developed and utilized by the Judicial Inquiry and Review Commission for the filing of a complaint shall also  
22 be made available to the public in paper form in every clerk's office in all state courts of the Commonwealth.  
23 In all such courts, a sign shall be posted in a location accessible to the public that notes the availability and  
24 location of such paper forms in the office.*25 **§ 19.2-43.1. Complaint forms; availability in courthouses.**26 *Any standardized form developed and utilized by the Department of Magistrate Services in the Office of  
27 the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court of Virginia for the filing of a complaint against a magistrate  
28 shall be made available to the public in paper form in every clerk's office in all state courts of the  
29 Commonwealth. In all such courts, a sign shall be posted in a location accessible to the public that notes the  
30 availability and location of such paper forms in the clerk's office.*
