4 A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Chapter 8 of Title 36 a section numbered 36-140.02,
5 relating to Department of Housing and Community Development; Eviction Reduction Program; report.

8 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

9 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 8 of Title 36 a section numbered
10 36-140.02 as follows:

11 § 36-140.02. *Eviction Reduction Program; report.*

12 A. The Department shall establish the Eviction Reduction Program (the Program) to (i) promote housing
13 stability, (ii) identify barriers that contribute to eviction filings, (iii) provide interventions to prevent or divert
14 evictions, and (iv) carry out any efforts to support eviction prevention and diversion consistent with this
15 section and guidelines adopted by the Department. The Department shall develop criteria and guidelines
16 necessary to administer the Program, including program participation eligibility standards, application
17 procedures, and award procedures.

18 B. In administering the Program, the Department shall work in collaboration with the Eviction Diversion
19 Program (§ 55.1-1260 et seq.) to coordinate eviction prevention and diversion support and to maximize
20 housing stability outcomes.

21 C. On or before October 1 of each year, the Department shall report to the General Assembly on (i) the
22 number of households served and the outcomes for such households, (ii) the types of assistance provided, (iii)
23 the geographic distribution of the Program, and (iv) any legislative recommendations it has to help further
24 the goals of the Program.

25 D. Nothing in this section shall be construed to impair or affect any rights, obligations, agreements, or
26 actions taken by the Department pursuant to the Eviction Reduction Program prior to the enactment of the
27 provisions under this section.
