10 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**11 **1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 32.1-127.4 and 63.2-1801.1 as**
12 **follows:**13 **§ 32.1-127.4. Publicly accessible nursing home information portal; reporting of incidents involving**
14 **emergency medical services.**15 *A. The Department shall develop and maintain a publicly accessible nursing home information portal that*
16 *consolidates and displays publicly available information, including inspection and survey results,*
17 *disciplinary actions, and key facility performance metrics. Such portal shall be categorized by the name and*
18 *location of such nursing home. The Department shall ensure that such portal is plainly and clearly accessible*
19 *from the home page of its website.*20 *B. Nursing home operators shall submit a quarterly report to the Department with information on*
21 *incidents at such nursing home involving emergency medical services. Such report shall include (i) the*
22 *number of incidents that occurred involving emergency medical services; (ii) the party who called for or*
23 *solicited assistance from emergency medical services; (iii) any care rendered by emergency medical services*
24 *and the outcome of such care; and (iv) any additional information that the Department deems relevant. The*
25 *information reported pursuant to this subsection shall be included in the portal established pursuant to*
26 *subsection A.*27 *C. The Board shall adopt regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this section.*28 **§ 63.2-1801.1. Publicly accessible assisted living facility information portal; reporting of incidents**
29 **involving emergency medical services.**30 *A. The Department shall develop and maintain a publicly accessible assisted living facility information*
31 *portal that consolidates and displays publicly available information, including inspection and survey results,*
32 *disciplinary actions, and key facility performance metrics. Such portal shall be categorized by the name and*
33 *location of such assisted living facility. The Department shall ensure that such portal is plainly and clearly*
34 *accessible from the home page of its website.*35 *B. Assisted living facility operators shall submit a quarterly report to the Department with information on*
36 *incidents at such assisted living facility involving emergency medical services. Such report shall include (i)*
37 *the number of incidents that occurred involving emergency medical services; (ii) the party who called for or*
38 *solicited assistance from emergency medical services; (iii) any care rendered by emergency medical services*
39 *and the outcome of such care; and (iv) any additional information that the Department deems relevant. The*
40 *information reported pursuant to this subsection shall be included in the portal established pursuant to*
41 *subsection A.*42 *C. The Board shall adopt regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this section.*
