**Bill Title:** Advisory Board on Behavior Analysis; composition.

**Bill Summary:** Amends the composition of the Advisory Board on Behavior Analysis to require that three members shall be licensed behavior analysts or licensed assistant behavior analysts who have practiced for at least three years. Current law specifies that Advisory Board members shall include two licensed behavior analysts who have practiced for at least three years and one licensed assistant behavior analyst who has practiced for at least three years.

**Fiscal Summary:** No fiscal impact.

**Fiscal Analysis:** This bill updates the membership specifications for the Advisory Board on Behavior Analysis but does not expand the total membership or duties of the Board.
