**Bill Number:** HB1139

**Patron:** Downey

**Bill Title:** Board of Medicine; membership; removal of residence requirements.

**Bill Summary:** Removes the requirement that the Board of Medicine have one physician from each congressional district and instead requires that 11 physicians are on the Board. The bill removes references to change of residence provisions for physician Board members.

**Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**Items Impacted:** n/a

**Fiscal Summary:** No fiscal impact.

**Fiscal Analysis:** This bill removes residence requirements for medical physician members of the Board of Medicine and makes technical updates to remove provisions contingent on such residence requirements. This action does not change the current membership or duties of the Board of Medicine; as such, it is not expected that this action will result in a fiscal impact for the Board of Medicine or the Department of Health Professions.
