Bill Title: Prohibition on trespassing on emergency vehicles; penalty.

Bill Summary: Provides that any person who enters or remains upon or within an emergency vehicle, defined in the bill, without the permission of, or after having been forbidden to do so by, the owner, lessee, or authorized operator is guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor.

Budget Amendment Necessary: No

Items Impacted: Non

Explanation: See below

Fiscal Summary: There is not enough information available to reliably estimate the increase in fine revenue as a result of this proposal that creates an additional Class 4 misdemeanor.

Fiscal Analysis:

A Class 4 misdemeanor is punishable by a fine of up to \$250. These offenses do not carry jail time. All revenue collected from such fines is deposited into the Literary Fund. However, it is not possible to estimate either the number of convictions that may result or the amount of each fine that may be assessed under this legislation. Therefore, the impact of this bill cannot be determined.

Proceeds of all fines and penalties collected for offenses committed against the Commonwealth are paid into the state treasury to the credit of the Literary Fund.
