Bill Title: Museums and other cultural institutions; Gunston Hall; meetings of the Board of Regents.

Bill Summary: Requires the Gunston Hall Board of Regents to meet in person at least once annually. The bill clarifies that any additional meeting of the Board held within the same calendar year may be in person or held as an all-virtual public meeting in compliance with the Virginia Freedom of Information Act. The bill contains an emergency clause.
