**Bill Number:** HB1063

**Patron:** Hodges

**Bill Title:** Inspection of certified nursing facilities; compliance with federal reporting requirements; civil penalty.

**Bill Summary:** Directs the Department of Health to maintain a list of agencies and organizations that submit requests for and receive opioid antagonists through its distribution program and requires the Department to submit a quarterly report to the Chairs of the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Health and Human Resources, House Health and Human Services Committee, Senate Finance and Appropriations Subcommittee on Health and Human Resources, and Senate Subcommittee on Health, and the chair of the Virginia Opioid Abatement Authority on its distribution of opioid antagonists. The bill requires the Department to submit an annual report to the Joint Commission on Health Care and the Chairs of the House Appropriations Committee and the Senate Finance and Appropriations Committee by December 1 of each year estimating the costs of the opioid antagonist distribution program for the following fiscal year using a methodology developed by the Department pursuant to parameters set out in the bill. This bill is a recommendation of the Joint Commission on Health Care.

**Fiscal Summary:** Minimal fiscal impact.

**Fiscal Analysis:** The provisions of this legislation are not expected to have any significant fiscal impact on the Virginia Department of Health (VDH). VDH indicates that any increase in workload to maintain a list of agencies and organizations, to develop a methodology to estimate the cost of an opioid antagonist distribution program, and submit an annual report can be handled within existing resources.
