**Bill Number:** HB622

**Bill Title:** Advanced practice registered nurses; authorization to practice without a practice agreement; service in military or employment with Department of Veterans Affairs.

**Bill Summary:** Permits advanced practice registered nurses who practiced autonomously for at least three years as part of either military service or employment with the United States Department of Veterans Affairs to practice without a practice agreement.

**Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**Items Impacted:** n/a

**Fiscal Summary:** No fiscal impact.

**Fiscal Analysis:** This legislation expands the list of advanced practice registered nurses eligible to practice without a practice agreement to include advanced practice registered nurses who practiced autonomously for at least three years during a period of active-duty military service or during employment with the United States Department of Veterans Affairs. This legislation clarifies the population of advanced practice registered nurses eligible to practice without a practice agreement and does not place new requirements on the Board of Medicine, the Board of Nursing, or the Department of Health Professions; accordingly, no fiscal impact is expected.
