Bill Title: Purchase of handguns or other weapons of certain officers; Department of State Police.

Bill Summary: Provides that the Department of State Police may allow the immediate survivor of any law-enforcement officer formerly employed by the Department who had at least 10 years of service with the Department and who died while receiving long-term disability payments to purchase his service handgun, with the approval of the Superintendent of State Police, at a price of \$1.

Fiscal Summary: Any impact as a result of this proposal is expected to be absorbed by the Department of State Police.

Fiscal Analysis: This proposal allows for immediate survivor of any law-enforcement officer formerly employed by the Department of State Police who had at least 10 years of service with the Department and who died while receiving long-term disability payments to purchase his service handgun, with the approval of the Superintendent of State Police, at a price of \$1. The Department of State Police anticipates that the agency will be able to absorb any impact as a result of this proposal.
