**Bill Number:** HB128

**Patron:** Callsen

**Bill Title:** Certification of ancillary traffic infractions.

**Bill Summary:** Allows the court to certify any ancillary traffic infraction to the clerk of the circuit court upon certification of any felony offense, provided that the attorney for the Commonwealth and the accused consent to such certification. Current law only allows ancillary misdemeanor offenses to be certified. This bill is a recommendation of the Virginia Criminal Justice Conference.

**Explanation:** N/A

**Fiscal Summary:** According to the Office of the Executive Secretary (OES) of the Supreme Court of Virginia and the Commonwealth's Attorneys' Services Council (CASC), there is no impact from this bill.
