3 *A BILL to amend and reenact § 32.1-248.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to public pools; regulations.*

4 Patron Prior to Engrossment—Delegate Hope

5 Referred to Committee on Health and Human Services

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 32.1-248.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 **§ 32.1-248.1. [Posting of water quality test results by certain recreational Regulations for public**

9 **aquatic] facilities.**

10 A. The Board of Health shall promulgate regulations to require the daily posting of water quality test

11 results at governing swimming pools and other water recreational facilities operated for public use or,

12 including swimming pools and other water recreational facilities operated in conjunction with a tourist

13 facility or health spa. Such regulations shall require, among other things, include requirements for (i) water

14 treatment and disinfection, (ii) the [daily] posting of water quality data regarding the current pH level,

15 disinfectant type and concentration, and water temperature, and the recommended safe levels of each, (iii)

16 safety equipment and features, (iv) maintenance and safety of equipment and premises, (v) operational

17 requirements, (vi) facility staffing, (vii) incident response, and (viii) such other provisions as may be

18 necessary to protect the public health and safety. Such regulations shall not (a) apply to private residential

19 water recreational facilities, as defined by the Board, or (b) regulate the design, construction, or maintenance

20 of pool structures and equipment as governed by the Uniform Statewide Building Code (§ 36-97 et seq.).

21 B. Nothing in this section or regulations of the Board shall prohibit any locality from adopting any

22 ordinance regarding the operation of swimming pools and other water recreational facilities operated for

23 public use that are equivalent to or more stringent than the regulations adopted pursuant to this section.
