**Bill Title:** Selling, giving, or distributing a tianeptine product; penalties.

**Bill Summary:** Under the substitute bill, a retail establishment that knowingly sells, gives, or distributes a tianeptine product, without a prescription, is subject to a civil penalty in the amount of \$500 for a first violation and a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500 for a second or subsequent violation within a three-year period. The substitute bill clarifies that for any violation of the proposal by an employee of a retail establishment, the penalty shall be assessed against the establishment.

**Fiscal Summary:**

This proposal would have an indeterminant impact on the Literary Fund revenues.

**Fiscal Analysis:**

This proposal creates specific fines for retail establishments that knowingly sells, gives, or distributes a tianeptine product, without a prescription. These facilities would be subject to a \$500 civil penalty for a first violation and a \$2,500 civil penalty for a second or subsequent violation within a three-year period.

Proceeds of all fines and penalties collected for offenses committed against the Commonwealth are paid into the state treasury to the credit of the Literary Fund.
