Bill Title: Hours of work for paid firefighters.

Bill Summary: Provides that the Department of Fire Programs shall encourage employers to implement work schedules that do not require any paid firefighter's normally scheduled shifts to exceed 42 hours per workweek.

Explanation: N/A

Fiscal Summary: The fiscal impact of the bill is indeterminate.

Fiscal Analysis: According to the Department of Fire Programs (DFP), the bill requires the agency to work with localities to encourage the adoption of a 42-hour work week for firefighters. However, the agency is uncertain of the extent to which it must engage with localities to meet the provisions of the bill. As such, the fiscal impact is indeterminate.

The fiscal impact on localities is indeterminate, as it is not possible to estimate how many localities will implement a 42-hour work week for fighters at this time.
