Bill Title: Constitutional amendment (voter referendum); qualifications of voters; right to vote; persons not entitled to vote.

Bill Summary: Provides for a referendum at the November 3, 2026, general election to approve or reject an amendment that would provide for the fundamental right to vote in the Commonwealth, revise the qualifications of voters so that a person convicted of a felony is not entitled to vote during his period of incarceration but is automatically invested with the right to vote upon release from incarceration, and update the existing prohibition on voting by persons found to be mentally incompetent to instead apply to persons who have been found to lack the capacity to understand the act of voting.

Fiscal Analysis: The Department of Elections (ELECT) estimates the cost to meet the requirements of section 30-19.9 of the Code of Virginia, required ELECT to run advertisements in state newspapers and prepare posters and pamphlets providing public notice about statewide referendums. Based on current estimates the cost will be \$205,000.
