**Bill Number:** HB943

**Patron:** Franklin

**Bill Title:** Free use of toll facilities; campus police officers.

**Bill Summary:** Authorizes campus police officers to use all toll bridges, toll ferries, toll tunnels, and toll roads in the Commonwealth without the payment of toll while in the performance of their official duties.

**Budget Amendment Necessary:** No

**Items Impacted:** N/A

**Explanation:** N/A

**Fiscal Summary:** The number and value of possible trips utilizing toll facilities by campus police officers in the performance of their official duties is unknown. As a result, the fiscal impact of this legislation from lost toll revenue is indeterminate. Given the limited size of the population of campus police officers, and restricting free use to while in the performance of their official duties, compared to the total utilization of toll facilities, revenue losses from this bill are not likely to be significant.
