**Bill Number:** SB37E                    **Patron:** Favola  
**Bill Title:** Sexual abuse during infancy or incapacity; accrual.

**Bill Summary:** Adds to the accrual provisions for personal injury actions resulting from sexual abuse during the infancy or incapacity of a person that accrual occurs when corroborative evidence, as defined in the bill, is discovered or by the exercise of due diligence reasonably should have been discovered.
