**Bill Title:** Virginia Public Procurement Act; additional public works contract requirements.

**Bill Summary:** Provides that public bodies shall require the contractor and its subcontractors for any capital outlay project, as defined in the bill, to complete certain safety training programs, maintain records of compliance with applicable laws, and participate in approved apprenticeship training programs. The bill provides exemptions from such requirements for reasons related to lack of availability of apprentices and high costs. The provisions of the bill do not apply to transportation-related construction projects. The substitute bill requires public bodies to make a declaration in writing that at least one apprentice has been hired and requires certification of internal policies that track and increase apprentice labor hours. The bill has a delayed effective date of July 1, 2027.

**Explanation:** The fiscal impact of this legislation is indeterminate.

**Fiscal Summary:** The Department of General Services indicates the fiscal impact of this legislation is indeterminate, as it may limit the pool of contractors and increase the construction cost of non-transportation-related capital projects.

**Other:** This bill is a companion to HB850 and similar to HB1046/SB324. SB962/HB2482 from the 2025 session also stipulated apprenticeship requirements for capital projects.
